Mitchell T. Saltzberg, MD, FACC, FAHA, currently serves (2007 – Current) as Medical Director of the Heart Failure and the Mechanical Circulatory Assist Programs at Christiana Care Health System and is the Program Director of the Advanced Heart and Transplant Cardiology Fellowship Program. He is a fellow of the American College of Cardiology and the American Heart Association. Dr. Saltzberg maintains an active research program at Christiana Care with interests in the use of electronic health systems in heart failure care, patient empowerment strategies, proactive care models, ultrafiltration and heart failure outcomes research.

Dr. Saltzberg is the former Medical Director of the Heart Failure Program and Co-Director of the Pulmonary Hypertension Center at Midwest Heart Specialists in Downers Grove, Illinois. Dr. Saltzberg graduated with distinction from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he earned his Bachelor of Science degree. He earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from Yale University, followed by an internal medicine residency at University of Chicago Hospital and a cardiology fellowship at Rush-Presbyterian St. Luke's Medical Center in Chicago. He served as Co-Director of the Cardiomyopathy and Transplant Unit at Rush and joined Midwest Heart Specialists in 2001 to serve as Medical Director of the Heart Failure Program. Dr. Saltzberg joined Christiana Care Health System in 2007.

Dr. Saltzberg has published numerous articles and book chapters on heart failure and issues related to cardiac transplant. He regularly lectures in his field in national and international arenas. Dr. Saltzberg serves as a reviewer for the Journal of Cardiac Failure, the Journal of Heart and Lung Transplantation, Circulation, the American Heart Journal and the Journal of the American College of Cardiology. He currently serves on the Education Committee and CME sub-committee of the Heart Failure Society of America and served as a member of the National Heart Failure and Transplantation Committee of the American College of Cardiology from 2002-2008.

Dr. Saltzberg is the only Board Certified Cardiologist in Advanced Heart Failure and Transplant Cardiology in the State of Delaware.
