Jack Colman is a Professor of Medicine and of Obstetrics & Gynaecology at the University of Toronto, where he was a founder of the Pregnancy and Heart Disease Program at Mount Sinai Hospital in 1989. He is a senior cardiologist at Mount Sinai Hospital and Peter Munk Cardiac Centre/UHN, and in the Toronto Congenital Cardiac Centre for Adults. He is a past president of the International Society for Adult Congenital Heart Disease. Dr. Colman graduated from Medicine at University of Toronto, did post-graduate training at McGill University in Montreal, and then returned to Toronto to take up the appointment he has held for 42 years. He began his career as a general cardiologist and echocardiographer, but through a gradual evolution, now complete, he has come to devote 100% of his clinical and research efforts to women with heart disease during pregnancy and to adults with congenital heart disease.
