



Prof. Mark Johnson is Professor in Clinical Obstetrics at Imperial College, based at Chelsea and Westminster Hospital. He qualified from St George's Hospital Medical School in 1982 after accrediting in General Medicine, Endocrinology and Diabetes, he retrained in Obstetrics and Gynaecology becoming dually accredited in 1999. His early research work focused on the neuroendocrinology of oxytocin and vasopressin, but later moved into the endocrinology of obstetrics focusing on the role of the hormone relaxin. Since then his research activity has focused on preterm labour and the impact of heart disease on pregnancy outcome.
